It has been an exciting few months for the AYA Cancer PSP! This fall we launched the initial PSP survey, which is a significant milestone in the James Lind Alliance priority setting process. With support from the AYA community, we received over 300 responses to the survey from AYAs, their loved ones, and clinicians from across Canada!

Our next steps are now to summarize the research questions that were submitted and check them against the existing research evidence to determine which questions have not yet been answered by research. Those questions will move forward to a second survey, which will launch in 2024. Stay tuned for more information.

All survey responses will be sorted and summary questions will be

Evidence Checking
The long list of questions is checked against existing research evidence
Any questions that have been answered will be removed.
Survey #2: Interim Priority Setting
To reduce the remaining long list, patients, caregivers, and clinicians w
vote on the most important questions. This is the short list of question
Final Workshop
The highest ranked 25-30 questions are discussed. Patients, caregiver
and clinics agree the "Top 10" list of priorities.
Dissemination
The Top 10 is announced.
